

Announcing a new course for Fall 2007:

Comparative & International Education (EDFN 845)

This course, an introduction to the fields of comparative and international education, provides an overview of comparative education theory, practice, and research methodology. We examine educational issues and school systems in diverse cultural contexts in the developing and the developed world. The course focuses on educational issues that transcend national boundaries. Among the topics we explore are gender, language policy, ethnicity, and citizenship. As a major project in the class, students will select an educational problem, which they analyze from a comparative perspective, applying the concepts and methodologies learned in class.
